John,

Greetings from Tokyo.

Phil Taylor and I have discussed Phil's review of the document that went out for review on March 2, and based on that discussion I would like to offer a few corrections to Appendix C.1.

In the second paragraph of Section C.1.2.1 (line 29 of page C.1-1), "0 to 100 oC" should be corrected to "0 to 150 oC" to allow for the potential case where gasification is performed at 150 C and the transfer lines maintained at 300 C.

Also, to better show that the transport testing will be done under conditions comparable to those to be employed during Phase II testing described in Appendix C.2.4 EXCEPT for lower temperature, another sentence should be added to Section C.1.2.1as follows:

With the exception of temperature as noted above, the target operating conditions for the high temperature reactor of the thermal reactor system will be consistent with the the conditions presented in Table C.2-1 in Appendix C.2.4.

As you know, the temperature for Phase 1 transport testing must be well below that planned for Phase II to assure transport (rather than decomposition) of the standard for which transport efficiency across the thermal reactor system is being measured.

If these corrections are acceptable to you, I would be glad to send in a

revised version of the Appendices with these corrections included. Please let me know what I can do to help.
