

VILLAGE OF ENDICOTT

A RESOLUTION APPROVING LOCAL LAW ___-2020

At a meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Endicott, held on the 20th day of April, 2020, the following resolution was offered and seconded:

WHEREAS, pursuant to an Emergency Order of the Governor of the State of New York, notice was given that the Village Board scheduled a public hearing for April 20, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom Video Conference for Local Law No. ___ of the Year 2020 entitled “A LOCAL LAW MAKING RECYCLING FACILITIES A PERMITTED USE IN INDUSTRIAL ZONES”; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly advertised in the official newspaper of the Village and posted on the Village Clerk’s signboard; and

WHEREAS, the Local Law was referred to the Village Planning Board and they recommended neither approval nor denial of the law; and

WHEREAS, the Broome County Planning Department reviewed the Local Law pursuant to GML § 239-m, and found no significant county-wide impacts; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly held on the 20th day of April, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. and all parties attending the videoconference were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said proposed Local Law, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Part 617 of the implementing regulations of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, it has been determined by the Village Board of the Village of Endicott that adoption of the proposed Local Law constitutes a Type I Action, as defined under said regulations. The Village Board has considered the possible environmental impacts of the Local Law. The adoption of said Local Law will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and the Village Board adopts a negative declaration with respect to the Local Law; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Village to adopt said Local Law in accordance with the criteria set forth in Section 300-61.7 of the Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of the Village of Endicott hereby adopts said Local Law as Law No. ___ of the Year 2020 entitled “A LOCAL LAW MAKING RECYCLING FACILITIES A PERMITTED USE IN INDUSTRIAL ZONES”; and it is further

RESOLVED that the Village Clerk be and hereby is directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State; and it is further

RESOLVED that this resolution will take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.
